An incredible synergy of space, light and materials has been created to make 140 Juniper Ridge one of the most thoughtful and unique examples of new western architecture and design to be found today.

Tucked away in a quiet draw, surrounded by native juniper, cedar and sage, this home is enveloped by sweeping vistas of the Valley floor, Beaver Creek and beyond, to the rugged Sawatch Mountain Range.

Uncompromised attention to detail is immediately evident with an amazing collection of reclaimed design elements, including wide-plank Austrian Volcano oak floors, patterned Travertine tile and unique granite and marble counters hand-chosen to match each room and space.

Floor-to-ceiling windows throughout, bathe each room in a warm light that brings out the brilliant grains of hand-hewn woods and coral seabed stone walls, while details such as carnival alabaster sconces and artisan, burnished wrought railings accentuate the sense of congruity with the mountain environment.

All the rooms in this home have been created to evoke their own sense of space and individuality, with features unique to each, including: designer alder cabinetry, doors and built-ins, distressed oak flooring, hand-crafted, Italian tile and wainscoting, natural pigment wool carpet and dry-stack artisan stone fireplaces and hearths.
